12. Reports:

a. Trustees Anderson and Schock to report on the MVCAC quarterly meeting held on October 26-28, 2016 Seaside, CA.

Trustee Anderson stated it was a good quarterly meeting. Topic of discussion included updates on the Zika virus and its impact to date in California. He also stated that the use of drones in mosquito control looks to be very promising and should benefit our district in the future.

Trustee Schock stated several of the topics presented were related to the two invasive species of mosquitoes *Aedes albopictus* and *Aedes aegypti*. He said it is concerning that a caregiver contracted the Zika virus from patient contact.


Trustee Petrie attended the trustee training session. Topics of discussion included how local Vector Control Districts and the California Department of Public Health conducted control efforts on the Zika virus and associated mosquitoes. Several of the techniques used to combat the mosquitoes proved effective this season. The spread of the invasive mosquitoes is increasing with each season. There is also concern that local mosquitoes could possibly be involved in local transmission of the Zika virus.
